OTHER BUSINESS

Roy Furrh, General Counsel of MDEQ, noted the meeting originally scheduled for February 11, 2014, was moved to today – Thursday, February 20, 2014, due to the icy weather conditions on February 11, which resulted in the MDEQ building being closed part of that day. A notice of rescheduled meeting was posted on February 12, 2014, whereby the originally scheduled February 11 meeting was rescheduled for 9:00 a.m., Thursday, February 20, 2014. Mr. Furrh recommended that the Permit Board include the notice of rescheduled meeting in its minutes.

On motion by Jim Lipe and seconded by Jan Boyd, the Permit Board voted to include the notice of rescheduled meeting in its minutes.

Mr. Furrh also indicated that at the March 18, 2014, Permit Board meeting there will be an evidentiary hearing regarding the modification of the Meridian POTW NPDES Permit and there will also be a presentation of the North Lee County Water Association proposed groundwater withdrawal permits. Guests will be present for the North Lee County Water Association matter.

Mr. Furrh also confirmed the MacLand II evidentiary hearing is scheduled for the regular Permit Board meeting on April 8, 2014.

Confirmation of next meeting was announced by Mr. Dennis Riecke for March 18, 2014.

EVIDENTIARY HEARING REGARDING KENTUCKY-TENNESSEE CLAY COMPANY, SURFACE MINING PERMIT NO. P98-046, BOND RELEASE, BENTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

The matter before the Permit Board was the final release of the remaining 70 percent of the performance bond to Kentucky-Tennessee Clay Company (KTC) for its Surface Mine (Permit No. P98-046), covering approximately 150 acres in Benton County, Mississippi. The Permit Board approved this final bond release at its regular meeting on November 12, 2013. Mr. Arnold Rooker, Sr. (Petitioner) submitted a written request for a formal evidentiary hearing, objecting to the Permit Board's decision to approve the final bond release to KTC.

Mr. Mike Bograd, Chief of the Office of Geology at MDEQ and an ex-officio member of the Permit Board, recused himself from the Evidentiary Hearing due to the Office of Geology being involved in the matter. Mr. Bograd departed prior to commencement of the hearing.

The hearing officer in this matter was Ricky Luke, Special Assistant Attorney General with the Office of the Attorney General. Senior Attorney Ted Lampton represented the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). Attorney Betty Ruth Fox represented KTC. Mr. Rooker appeared pro-se. MDEQ submitted prefiled direct testimony through the affidavits of Thomas Ray and James Matheny; and prefiled rebuttal testimony through the rebuttal affidavit of James Matheny. KTC submitted prefiled rebuttal testimony through the affidavit of David Foy. Petitioner submitted prefiled direct testimony through the written statements/letters of Arnold Rooker III, Linda Renick, Arnold Rooker, Sr., Ollice Massengill, Jr., Wayne Gadd, Senator Bill Stone, and Representative Steve Massengill; and prefiled rebuttal testimony through the written statement/letter of David Rooker.

PRELIMINARY MATTERS

Ms. Fox presented a Motion to Intervene on behalf of KTC. With no objection from MDEQ or Petitioner, Hearing Officer Luke submitted the Motion to the Permit Board for their consideration. Upon motion by Board Member Boyd and seconded by Board Member Lipe, the Permit Board unanimously voted to grant KTC's motion.

KTC then presented a Motion to Strike Petitioner's pre-filed video. MDEQ did not object to the Motion, but also did not object to the entry of the video into evidence, on grounds that other testimony at the hearing would provide context for the contents of the video. Petitioner objected to the Motion, arguing that he did not video anything except permitted areas. Hearing Officer Luke denied KTC's Motion to Strike Petitioner's pre-filed video, on grounds that the Permit Board needed to consider the evidence and testimony at the hearing so that they could determine which portions of the video, if any, should not be considered in making their final decision in this matter.

Petitioner moved *ore-tenus* that he be allowed to introduce an additional video of approximately five minutes in duration which he had not previously provided to MDEQ or KTC. KTC objected to the entry of the additional video into the record. MDEQ stated that no additional video had been provided to MDEQ for review. Hearing Officer Luke denied Petitioner's *ore-tenus* motion to introduce the additional video into the record on grounds that it had not been available for viewing by the parties and the parties did not agree to allow it into evidence.

KTC invoked the rule regarding sequestering of witnesses. Hearing Officer Luke directed all witnesses to leave the room, other than the parties' counsel and one corporate designee for each party. Hearing Officer Luke requested MDEQ's assistance in providing a suitable place for the witnesses to be sequestered during the hearing.

KTC moved *ore-tenus* that the pre-filed written statements of all witnesses who are not present at the hearing be stricken from the record. Hearing Officer Luke declined to rule on this *ore-tenus* motion until the end of the hearing, on grounds that the witnesses could possibly still show up during the hearing.

OPENING STATEMENTS, TESTIMONY, AND CLOSING STATEMENTS

Mr. Lampton made an opening statement on behalf of MDEQ. Ms. Fox made an opening statement on behalf of KTC. Mr. Rooker, Sr., made an opening statement on behalf of Petitioner.

Thomas Ray testified for MDEQ through his prefiled direct testimony. MDEQ tendered Mr. Ray for cross-examination by KTC and Petitioner; and submitted Mr. Ray for questioning by the Permit Board. Mr. Ray was cross-examined by both KTC and Petitioner; was questioned by Board Member Snodgrass; was re-directed by MDEQ; and was questioned by Board Chairman Riecke. James Matheny testified for MDEQ through his prefiled direct testimony and prefiled rebuttal testimony. MDEQ tendered Mr. Matheny for cross-examination by KTC and Petitioner; and submitted Mr. Matheny for questioning by the Permit Board. Mr. Matheny was cross-examined by both KTC and Petitioner; was questioned by Board Chairman Riecke; was questioned by Hearing Officer Luke, and was re-directed by MDEQ.

David Foy testified for KTC through his prefiled rebuttal testimony. KTC tendered Mr. Foy for cross-examination by MDEQ and Petitioner and submitted Mr. Foy for questioning by the Permit Board. MDEQ declined to cross-examine Mr. Foy. Petitioner cross-examined Mr. Foy. Board Chairman Riecke questioned Mr. Foy; and KTC redirected Mr. Foy.

Arnold Rooker, III, testified for Petitioner through his prefiled direct testimony. Petitioner tendered Mr. Arnold Rooker, III, for cross-examination by MDEQ and KTC and submitted Mr. Arnold Rooker, III, for questioning by the Permit Board. MDEQ did not cross-examine Mr. Arnold Rooker, III. KTC cross-examined Mr. Arnold Rooker, III. The Permit Board had no questions for Mr. Arnold Rooker, III. Petitioner re-directed Mr. Arnold Rooker, III.

David Rooker testified for Petitioner through his prefiled rebuttal testimony. Petitioner tendered Mr. David Rooker for cross-examination by MDEQ and KTC and submitted Mr. David Rooker for questioning by the Permit Board. MDEQ cross-examined Mr. David Rooker. KTC did not cross-examine David Rooker. Board Chairman Riecke questioned Mr. David Rooker; and Petitioner re-directed Mr. David Rooker.

Linda Renick testified for Petitioner through her prefiled direct testimony. Petitioner tendered Ms. Renick for cross-examination by MDEQ and KTC, and submitted Ms. Renick for questioning by the Permit Board. MDEQ did not cross-examine Ms. Renick. KTC cross-examined Ms. Renick. The Permit Board had no questions for Ms. Renick. Petitioner re-directed Ms. Renick.

Arnold Rooker Sr. testified for Petitioner (himself) through his prefiled direct testimony. Mr. Arnold Rooker, Sr. remained on the stand for cross-examination by MDEQ and KTC, and was available on the stand for questioning by the Permit Board. Board Member Lipe questioned Mr. Arnold Rooker Sr. MDEQ and KTC both cross-examined Mr. Rooker, Sr.; Board Chairman Riecke questioned Mr. Rooker, Sr.; and Mr. Rooker, Sr. provided re-direct testimony.

At the conclusion of all testimony, KTC moved that the additional pre-filed witness statements provided by Petitioner, for which the witnesses were not present at the hearing, be stricken from the record. Hearing Officer Luke granted the motion and ruled that the prefiled statements of Ollice Massengill, Jr., Wayne Gadd, Senator Bill Stone, and Representative Steve Massengill be stricken from the record because these witnesses were not present at the hearing for cross-examination.

Ms. Fox then moved that the video statements in Petitioner's prefiled direct video be stricken because the witnesses making the statements were not present at the hearing. Hearing Officer Luke granted the Motion to strike the portion of the video where witnesses who were not present at the hearing made taped video statements; and directed that the Permit Board not consider the portion of the video that contains videotaped statements of witnesses who are not present at the hearing.

Mr. Lampton, Ms. Fox, and Mr. Rooker made closing statements. The matters were then presented to the Permit Board for its decision.


DECISION OF THE PERMIT BOARD
